

## GENERAL CAMPING RULES

Each Scout must have a adult over the age of 21 accompany him on all overnight campouts.

**Scouts are not allowed to sleep in a tent with any other adult other than their own adult partners.** There is no exception to this rule. Scouts may sleep together in the same tent, but no adult is permitted.

Playing in the fire is **STRICTLY PROHIBITED**. Scouts are not allowed to add wood or throw items in to the fire. There will be no jabbing, stirring or flicking of sticks in the fire. If we have marshmallows or wiener roasts the scouts will be supervised at all times. **SAFETY IS THE NUMBER ONE CONCERN.**

The adult partner is responsible for their scout. If they retire for the evening then the scout should retire with them.

If siblings or guests come to a Pack campout they are expected to follow the same guidelines as the scouts. **EVERYONE** (parents, adult partners, siblings and guests) are expected to practice the **LEAVE NO TRACE GUIDELINES**. A trashed campsite will not be tolerated. The campsite will be inspected by the Cubmaster or designated Leader prior to departure.

No weapons are allowed. Pocket knives may be carried on by scouts who have earned the Whittlin Chip Card and only with his specific Den Leaders knowledge and approval.

No Alcoholic beverages

Heaters are no allowed inside the tent. Candles, matches or lighters are not allowed inside a tent.

Camp Pinetreat does **NOT ALLOW SMOKING** at any time. **PETS** are not allowed either.

\*\*\*\*\*If in violation of the above rules you may be asked to leave the campout. This may also result in no participation for future camp outs. These rules are for the safety off all campers.\*\*\*\*\*
